Youth IT Careers gives young people, who face barriers to employment, their first step towards an IT career.

The program provides IT training, exposure to the industry and employment opportunities.

Capacity of class size is a maximum of 15 participants.

ELIGIBILITY

- 18 25 years old
- Australian or New Zealand citizen or permanent resident
- In receipt of an Australian Government welfare benefit or allowance (e.g. Youth Allowance, Newstart)
- Interest in IT and wanting to further their IT skills to gain relevant employment

PATHWAY PLANNING

The program will help students to set future education and or employment goals. Students are supported to achieve their chosen pathway that may include identifying and preparing for applying for traineeships within the IT industry.

WHAT WILL IT COST?

Fully funded under a government supported place and other subsidies, no tuition or material fees.

TIME COMMITMENT

- 9am to 3pm Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday (Wednesday non-attendance day)
- 10 Weeks (9 weeks with a one week break mid program)

DELIVERY MODE

On campus. The theory or knowledge required for the program is delivered in class by the teacher. Skills are then practiced in the classroom using a variety of software applications, hardware and operating systems.

- · Industry tours
- Guest speakers with industry professionals
- Mock interviews with industry professionals
- Work readiness/employability skills training

Once training has been completed, students will be supported to apply for a paid IT traineeship with a Youth IT Careers business partner.
